Through her leadership, scholarship, and critical arts writing, Denise reimagines the role of arts organizations in fostering equity and healing, offering a powerful reminder of creativity's ability to resist, restore, and inspire.

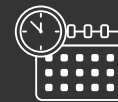

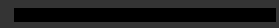

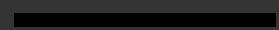
